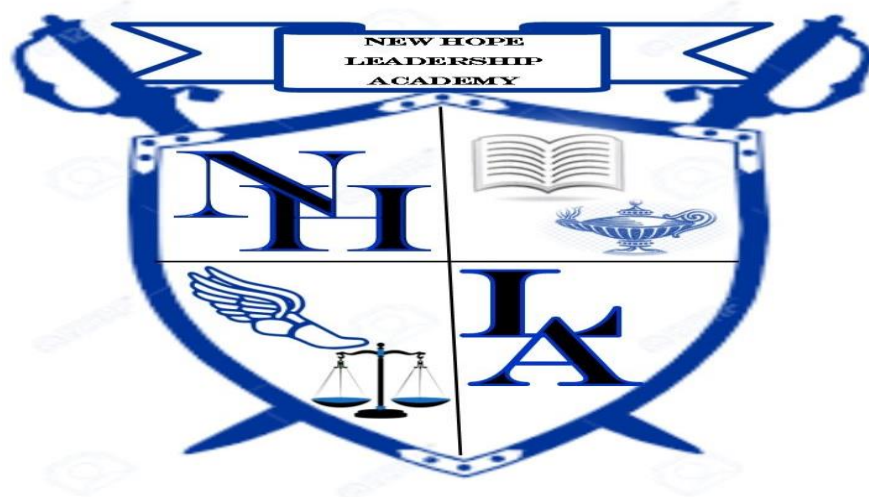

Overview

Introduction

MALES of New Hope is a community-based mentoring program which provides social, leadership and character building skills to male students ages 13-19 to prepare them to be productive citizens once they have completed high school. The program is designed to provide students with career awareness, self-esteem, decision making skills and conflict resolution skills. Young men will learn to bridge the gap between academics and social and emotional fitness while establishing nurturing positive relationships with their peers and adults. The program is intended to help students learn to cope with the everyday struggles of teen life in a supportive environment. By doing this, students will have a higher likelihood of avoiding teen violence, succeeding academically and being prepared to pursue the post-secondary academic or career opportunities of their choice.

The program will also teach the students social, interpersonal and life skills. This portion of the program will be conducted by onsite mentors and members from the community. The program will also assist the student with coping skills, critical thinking, developing a positive self-image and improving self-esteem.

Goals/Objectives

- ***To develop interpersonal skills***
- ***To improve self-esteem***
- ***To improve decision making***
- ***Character building***

We will also involve parents so that they can gain information that will assist them in the upbringing of young men in their families.

Our objective is to assist those young males throughout the communities of Richland and Lexington counties by introducing a rite of passage that encourages personal growth and higher aspirations. Community Service will become symbolic of personal achievement, ambition and the desire to be a force for good in the community.

Activities

There will be a variety of activities for this program. Activities will be designed to present information in a way that is deferential to the different learning styles. Student learning objectives and activities will be based on the ***Overcoming Obstacles Curriculum and My Classroom Economy*** which is a research based program that has proven effective in making students less susceptible to bullying, violence, substance abuse, dropping out of school, and unemployment. Students will also have a mentor from New Hope Leadership Academy and there will be guest speakers to provide insight about their area of expertise. The program will end every fall and spring with an awards banquet and mentoring day.
